



# CRIME STATISTICS

*Under the federal “Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act”, formerly the Student Right to Know and Campus Security Act, the Berkeley campus must annually distribute statistics on the reported occurrences of the following offenses:*

- Homicide
- Manslaughter
- Robbery
- Aggravated Assault
- Sex Offenses - forcible (rape, sodomy, rape with a foreign object, and forcible fondling (sexual battery)
- Sex Offenses - non forcible (incest and statutory rape)
- Burglary
- Motor Vehicle Theft
- Arson
- Statistics involving the above offenses or others involving bodily injury where there is evidence of victim selection based upon actual or perceived race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, or disability (hate crimes).
- Arrests or persons referred for campus disciplinary action for liquor law violations, drug abuse violations and weapons possession.

These offenses must be reported according to their occurrence in the following location categories:

- Campus - campus property (including residence halls or other on campus residences)
- Non-campus - University property not contiguous to main campus that is in direct support of the University and is frequented by students, or property owned or controlled by officially recognized student organizations (including Greeks and Co-ops)
- Residence Halls - campus-owned and controlled residences
- Public Property - public property surrounding “campus” property

Statistics for residence halls and campus owned residences do not include University Albany Village (UAV) statistics. UAV property is not contiguous to main campus and therefore is classified as a non-campus property under Jeanne Clery Act.

Criminal activities, if any, at off-campus student organizations (those recognized by the campus) are required to be monitored and recorded through local police agencies. This is required under 20 USC 1092(f) The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act.

In cases of criminal activities at off-campus student organizations the local agency will create a police report and case number for each incident, pursuant to their own procedures for recording criminal incident reports and using FBI Uniform Crime Reporting standards. The agency will then, upon request from UCPD, send statistics under The Clery Act offense categories, for each location which meets the criteria for off-campus student organization. Statistics for the current calendar year will appear in The Clery Act publication, Safety Counts, the following academic year.

### *An Explanation of the Statistics Charts*

These statistics reflect crime reported to the police for 1998, 1999 and 2000 as required under The Clery Act of 1998. Statistics reflect the numbers of crime reports occurring in the offenses categories required under The Clery Act of 1998. Offense categories under The Clery Act cover four types of areas: Campus, Affiliated/Non-Campus, Housing, and Public Property.

“Offenses Reported to Police” reflect crimes reported to the University of California Police Department and the City of Berkeley Police Department during the calendar years listed. “Unverified Offenses” reflect alleged crimes reported to other campus departments during the calendar years listed. Some incidents listed may not actually meet the criteria for their incident type. Although every effort has been made to avoid duplication between non-police department and police reports, individual incidents may be reported multiple times within the same calendar year.
